### **Pastor's Report**

- ☉ St Leo's ended the year financially fairly well. We made up our shortfall with additional rents. Income was what was expected; expenditures haven't been finalized yet, but preliminary analysis suggests they were under budget.
- ☉ Fr. Robert H; OFM is seeking refuge from Holy Family Friary's kitchen mold and related health issues. He will live in the room formerly inhabited by Fr. Gabriel for about a month.
- ☉ Music program coordinator for 5 and 8:30 Masses is moving to Olympia. Terry and Barbara Bang will be the coordinators of the music program for Saturday and Sunday 5 and 8:30 Masses. They have experience in doing parish music.
- ☉ The new maintenance person is leaving, and staying on until we find someone.
- ☉ Bishop Vigneron will meet with Pastoral Councils on January 17.

### **Pastoral Assistant Report**

- ☉ There are four separate RCIA/RCIC Rites of Election for the diocese. We're hoping to get St. Anthony's, which is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Lent. That Sunday will also include the Penitential Rite at 11am Mass.
